Criteria

Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the Year

Central Goldfields Shire Council Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the Year recipients are people who have demonstrated through their hard work and dedication that they:

- Provide a significant contribution to the Central Goldfields Shire community in the current year or over a number of years;
- Demonstrate outstanding skills and/or are a role model for other community members or organisations; and
- Excel in one of the areas of community services, arts and culture, sport and recreation, education or the environment.

Community Award of the Year

Community Award of the Year is presented to an event, initiative, organisation or other worthy entry for an outstanding contribution to the community during 2018.

Eligibility

Nominees for Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the Year must be residents of Central Goldfields Shire.

Nominees for Young Citizen of the Year must be 27 years or younger on 26 January, 2019.

Community Award must be an event, initiative or organisation within the municipality.

Nomination process

- Nominations must be on the official form (one nomination per form).
- All entries must be received no later than 3 December, 2019
- The name of at least one referee must be supplied. This person may be contacted if the nominee is shortlisted.
- All nomination information and material submitted remains the property of Central Goldfields Shire Council.
- The decision of Central Goldfields Shire Council in relation to the awards is final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect to the decision.
- Additional information which supports the nomination, such as newspaper articles can be attached to the form.
- Awards will be presented at the annual Australia Day Celebrations on 26 January 2019, at Station Domain Maryborough.
